Access Central-NT

The NT version of Access Central is designed for a 100% Windows operating environment that allows network administrators to implement the full capabilities of Microsoft Access across the network for multitasking, network-wide work groups, and passwords. The only security system software running on the NT Work Station is Microsoft Access, and the Access Central application database. The Access Central system is controlled entirely from the NT Work Station.

Access Central-NT uses a dedicated Access Server which is connected to the NT network. This server may be any inexpensive PC running Windows 95 or 98 with a network card. All Access Control System readers and field components connect directly to the Access Server. The use of an Access Server brings many powerful benefits to an Access Central system such as full Distributed Processing, multiple servers for expanded systems or remote sites, and immunization from faults or other anomalies on the NT Network which could otherwise compromise security.
